Fuel Mix Disclosure Notice April 2020-March 2021

The Electricity (Fuel Mix Disclosure) Regulations 2005 inserted a new standard condition into electricity supply licences requiring licensees to notify customers annually of the fuel source and environmental impact of electricity supplied to them each year.

The average fuel mix of the total amount of electricity purchased for supply by UK Power Reserve Limited during the period 1 April 2020 to 31 March 2021 was as follows:

Coal	6	2.7
Natural gas	74.5	38.2
Nuclear	9.8	16.1
Renewable	3.5	40.3
Other	6.2	2.7

The environmental impact on a per kWh basis is as follows:

	Electricity supplied by UKPR	GB Average (for comparison)
Emissions of carbon dioxide	392g/kWh	194g/kWh
Production of High Level Radioactive Waste	0.000686g/kWh	0.001127g/kWh
